wait for.

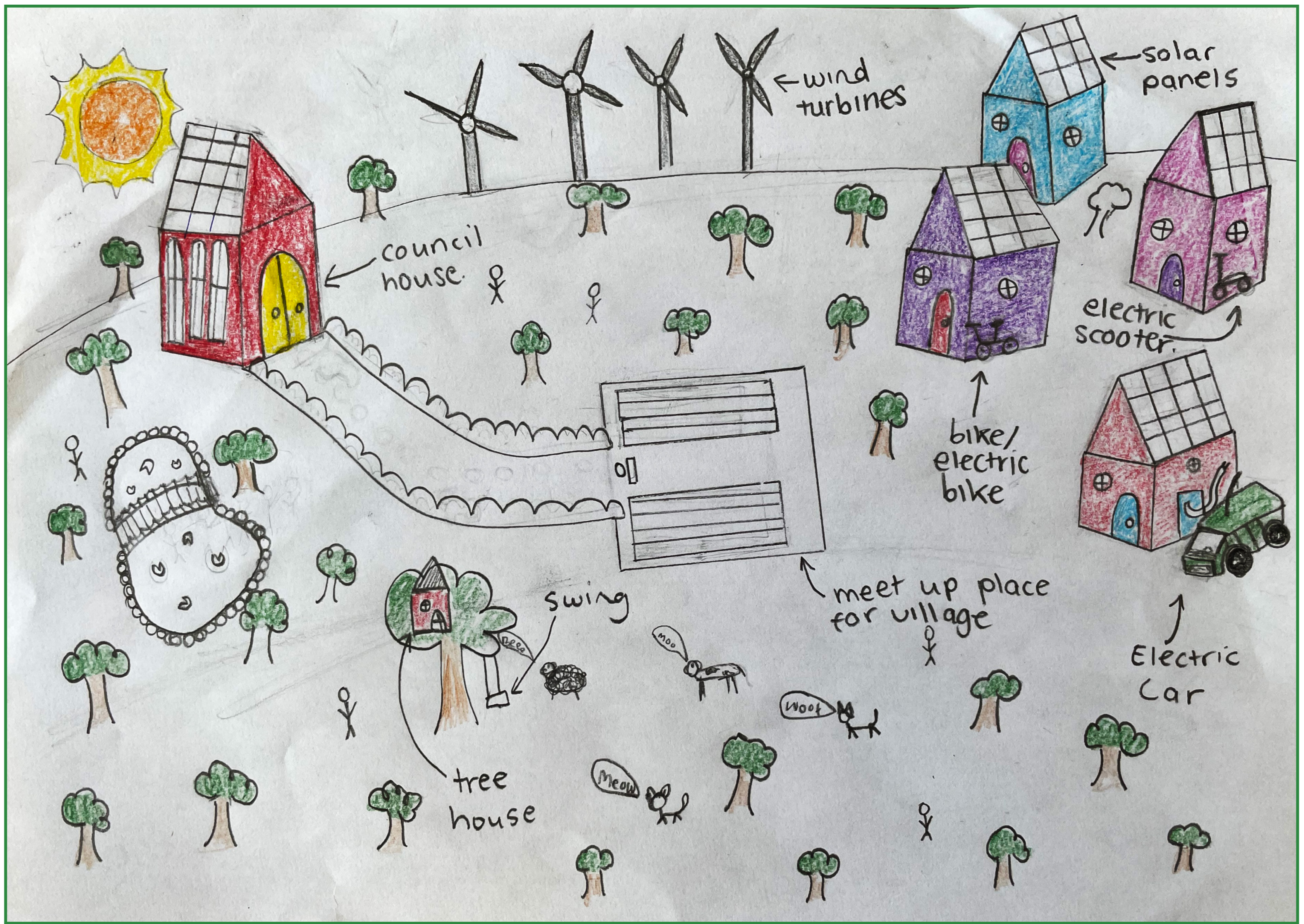
